RULES & GUIDELINES

To do that, we ask that you follow our campground rules. If you ever need help or have questions, stop by the camp office!

Hours of Operation: **Hours of operation may vary by season. Please check with our team when you arrive.

Camp Store: 9:00 am – 5:00 pm

Quiet Hours: 11:00 pm to 7:00 am

Pool Hours: Our pool is open Memorial Day to Labor Day and hours are 10:00 am - 12:00 am.

Recreation: Our campground has fun recreation options for campers of all ages! Be sure to play a round of mini golf, go mining for gemstones, bounce on the inflatables, or splash into our beautiful pool!

Unique Amenities at our Campground:

Our campers are welcome to utilize the Grayline Tour service from our neighbors at the Nashville KOA Resort. Their representatives can assist you with planning a local tour, booking tickets to shows, and getting around the city. They even have transportation options that pick you up from the KOA campground!

Speed Limit: 6 2/3 mph

Golf Cart and Alternative Transportation Policy:

While you cruise around the campground, make sure to follow this policy and campground speed limit. The laws of the road are still in effect in the campground, please make sure to stop at stop signs. Let's keep the lights on after dark, and make sure your transportation only carries the recommended number of passengers or less. We want everyone to be safe, with only licensed drivers operating motorized vehicles. If it has wheels, please follow these safety guidelines.

Pet Policy: Traveling with your furry friend? We have a dog park for our four-legged friends to stretch their legs. Pets must be on a leash outside of the dog park, and we ask owners to do their duty and clean up after their pets. Pets don't like to be left alone, so please don't leave them unattended. Due to health and safety regulations, pets are not allowed in any buildings, pool area, and other signed locations. *Certified service animals excluded.

Trash And Recycling Policy: Please place bagged trash next to the road at your site by 8:00 am for pickup. Wildlife frequently visits, so after 10:00 am use the dumpster locations for immediate disposal.

Visitor Policy: All visitors must stop by the office prior to entering the park and pick up a guest pass. Visiting guests permitted until Quiet Hours and must adhere to campground rules. Overnight guests need to register at the front desk. Visitor fees may apply.

Washing of Vehicles: Water conservation is a priority at our campground. Please check with our team before washing your vehicle.

Wildlife: Various types of wildlife big and small may be found on and around this campground. Be alert and give them distance and respect. Keep dogs on a leash and properly store food, trash, and cooking supplies. For the health of the wildlife, please refrain from feeding the animals. Your safety and the future of our wildlife depend on you.

PUTTING OUT YOUR CAMPFIRE:

1. Drown the fire with water. Make sure all embers, sticks, and logs are wet.
2. Stir the remains, add more water, and stir again. Be sure all burned material has been put out and cooled. Feel above the fire with the back of your hand to make sure it is out cold.
3. Before you leave the fire pit, be sure all embers, sticks and logs are completely extinguished. Never go to bed and allow the fire to burn itself out.
4. Never remove any ashes from the fire pit.
5. Never leave children or pets unattended near a fire pit even if you believe the fire is out cold.
